The transfer station, located at N2401 Pelishek Road, has summer and winter hours.

Winter Hours:

November 1st through March 30th
1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month
(5th Saturday if there is one)
9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Summer Hours:

April 1st through October 31st
Every Saturday of the month
9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Where Do I Pay My Taxes?

To pay your **first** installment tax payments (due by Jan. 31, 2015):

- In person, at **clerk's office** during regular business hours and on Saturday, December 27 from 9 am to Noon.
- **By mail.** PO Box 88, Adell. If you would like a receipt, you must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- At **National Exchange Bank & Trust in Adell**, during regular business hours or use night drop-box. If you would like a receipt, you must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.

To pay your **second** installment tax payments (due July 31, 2015):

- By mail to the **county treasurer's office.** Address is printed on your tax bill. If you would like a receipt, you must enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- In person, at the county treasurer's office.

Please do not send your second installment to the town clerk's office. This will only delay a timely payment because it has to then forwarded on to the county via USPS mail. Thank you for your cooperation! ❁

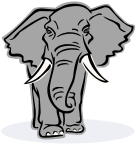
Recycling Information from WI DNR

The local positions to be filled at this election are Town Chair (Incumbent William Goehring), Town Supervisor (Incumbent Pat Horne), Town Supervisor (Incumbent Kris Klein) and Town Constable (Incumbent Jeff Kreuzinger). Nomination papers are available starting December 1, 2014 and are due by 5:00 p.m. on January 6, 2015. Building permits, electrical permits, plumbing permits and HVAC permits are required. Please call Building Inspector Walt Grotelueschen at 262/675-0909.

Diggers Hotline - Call 811 or 1-800-242-8511 or www.diggershotline.com BEFORE YOU DIG. This service is free of charge. The Hotline is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days per year.

Disposal of Sharps - Recommended disposal options are to re-sheathe sharps and contact your local doctor, clinic, pharmacy, hospital or public health department for information on sharps collection stations. You may dispose of the sharps in rigid puncture-resistant containers with secure lids or caps, such as heavy plastic laundry detergent or bleach containers with screw caps. Please label these containers "SHARPS" DO NOT RECYCLE, and dispose of them at a collection station. These containers SHOULD NOT BE PLACED WITH YOUR HOUSEHOLD TRASH OR RECYCLABLES.

Dog Licenses - Dog licenses expire December 31 of each year. Licenses obtained after March 31 will be charged a \$10 late fee in addition to the license fee of \$6 for neutered or spayed dogs and \$13 for unneutered or unsprayed dogs. You **MUST** bring in a rabies certificate in order to obtain a dog license. REMEMBER: as a pet owner you have the responsibility to license, have vaccinated, and keep control and pick-up after your pet. Failure to do any of the above is a violation of State and Local laws and is subject to fines.

Election Forms – If you need to register to vote, or apply for an absentee ballot for an upcoming election, DO NOT WAIT! Contact the clerk at 994-9421 or download those forms from the website. Click on "Election Information".

Most **Electronics** MAY NOT be put in the trash. E-Cycle Wisconsin helps you find a place to recycle your old electronics. Google "E-Cycle Wisconsin" for details.

Notary Service is available to Town residents during regular office hours. Bring your Driver's License along to

verify your signature and do not sign the document ahead of time.

Public Notices - Agendas are posted at National Exchange Bank & Trust in Adell, at the Silver Creek Fire Hall (front of building), and at MSM Mobil on STH 57 at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting. The Sounder is the official newspaper of the Town of Sherman.

Snow Plows - Please stay back at least 500' from snowplows. They are unable to see you due to the blowing snow.

| December 27, 2014 | Saturday Tax Collection at the Clerk's office for making payments in person. |
| January 6 | If running for local office, nomination papers are due by 5:00 p.m. |
| January 31 | Last day to pay 1 st installment of taxes |
| February 17 | Primary Election, if necessary |
| March 31 | Dog licensing deadline. Any dogs licensed after this date must pay \$10 late fee. |
| April 1 | Summer hours now in effect at the Transfer Station |
| April 7 | Spring Election |
| April 21 | 166 th Annual Town Meeting, 8 p.m. |
| April or May | Open Book for taxpayers to discuss assessment in an informal setting with the assessor. Watch The Sounder or website for the actual date. |
| May | Board of Review – If you are not satisfied with your assessment after the Open Book, you may appeal to this board which is comprised of local officials. Watch The Sounder of website for the actual date. |
| June 30 | All liquor and operator licenses expire. |
| July 31 | Last day to pay 2 nd installment of taxes. This payment MUST be made to Sheboygan County, either in person or by mail. DO NOT send to the town clerk. |
| November 1 | Winter Hours now in effect at the Transfer Station |
