



U.S. Passport (Book & Card) Accepted Voter Identification

Voter Photo ID Law

Who is included?

Wisconsin Residents

When applying for an original (first) US Passport you must:

- Apply in-person at an Acceptance Facility or Passport Agency
- Complete and Submit the **Application for a US Passport**
- Submit proof of U.S. Citizenship and Identification*
*see back for more details
- Pay applicable fee
- Provide one passport-ready photo

Must be renewed whenever a legal name change occurs.

A U.S. Passport can be used as valid photo ID for voting purposes.

Voters can use either their U.S. Passport book or card to satisfy the photo ID requirement.

The U.S. Passport document should be unexpired, or have an expiration date after the most recent general election; currently, **November 4, 2014**

No additional documents are required to satisfy the photo ID requirement if a voter is using a U.S. Passport document.

Original Documents

Documents showing Proof of Citizenship must be original. All documentation will be returned with your newly issued passport or in a separate mailing.

Proof of Identification

US PASSPORT
(previously issued & undamaged)

(U.S. & valid)

(military & dependents)

CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION

SECONDARY

Signature documents are used to verify personal identity. Submit as many as possible.

SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

OR

An Identifying Witness -

Someone who can swear to your identity that is present at the time of application

He or she must:

- Have known you for at least 2 years
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Have valid ID
- Fill out an Affidavit of Identifying Witness in the presence of a Passport Agent

For best results present signature documents and an identifying witness.

Documents submitted as Proof of Identification do not have to be original.

Only photocopies of Proof of Identification documents are acceptable.
